This awareness level training will feature presentations from the national perspective about what RTI is and is not, its alignment with other initiatives, as well as the state's perspective about where we are in terms of three-tiered models of intervention.

Schools currently implementing RTI will be showcased along with discussion about resources to assist districts in exploring initial steps to implementation.

Participants are required to attend in district teams of three (3) or more with at least one administrator, e.g. superintendents, principals, or directors.
