



***NEW* End of Course Exception Collection**

SUBJECT: *NEW* End of Course Exception Collection

The End of Course Exception collection is now available to report in the MOSIS Data Collection System. This new collection allows school districts to report End of Course exceptions and is due by the end of June. A letter was sent to school administrators with details of this new collection. To facilitate reporting of this new collection, the EOC Exception List Report has been added to the February Student Core collection under reports. This report includes 12th graders who are enrolled on the January count date that do not have an EOC assessment record. Districts should download this report and make any modifications needed. Modifications include removing students who took the assessment during the Spring administration, adding students who may not have been enrolled on the January count date, and including the exception reason for each student. Once modified, this file can be uploaded to the EOC Exception collection.

A MAP EOC History Report is also available in Crystal reports which can be reviewed to determine if a student has participated in each of the four EOC assessments. This is available by choosing the Web Applications on the DESE website and logging in with your username/password. You can then choose Reports, MAP Results, and Administrative from the list.
