SUBJECT: Reviewing April Student Core

In preparation for processing the assessment data (June ID/Clean-Up Cycle and the link to the April Student Core file) the certified April trials are being reviewed to help with data accuracy.

We encourage you to review your April Student Core submission for all required fields. Within the MOSIS Data Collection trial for April, there is a report named April 2010 Student Core Data Aggregation that does a count of each field in your trial, as a basic check you may just verify these numbers look accurate. For example, the IEP field generally would not have every student marked as having an IEP, and so by viewing it you may notice the number looks too high or too low. Another example has been districts coded all students as in the building less than a full academic year (Not FAY).

Some Reminders:

- The June ID/Clean-Up Cycle is scheduled to be turned on June 21st and will remain open for 2 weeks.
- The Special Education Program Exit Code is optional for April, if a student is no longer identified as receiving special education services at the time of testing then they should be reported in the IEP Disability as 00 for none.
