SUBJECT: MOSIS Data Collection Business Rule Changes

Effective Friday, September 24, 2010 the following business rules will go into effect.

October Cycle – Educator School File

Rule EDS03100—this rule warned users if a salary appeared too high. The rule has changed to now look at salary rate (salary/FTE), and the threshold was increased to \$100,000. Any educator which has an educator school record with a salary rate \$100,000 or higher will receive this warning.

Rule EDS03103—this rule was not evaluating educators which had a Masters or better degree and less than 10 years of public experience like it should have been. This has been corrected.

Rules EDS03104 and EDS03105--these rules have been added to require a salary if there is an FTE for the educator, and the reverse if there is an FTE then a salary must be provided.

June Cycle – Student Discipline File

Rule SDI00614—this rule was previously an error but has been changed to a warning. This rule restricts a student being reported for multiple discipline incidents on the same day.

February Cycle – Graduate Follow-up File

Rule GRD00702--added as a warning in January 2010 for the 2010 and 2009 Graduate Follow-up collection. This rule restricts students being sent from an area career. The Reporting School Code cannot be 1100. The reporting school code should instead be the High School from which the student graduated. If your student did graduate from the career center you should contact the department in order to clarify the situation. In the future this rule may be changed from a warning to an error. This message is to inform everyone of the coming change and identify the violations that need addressed in prior year submissions.
