DIRECTOR / PRODUCER

Produce or direct stage, television, radio, video, or motion picture productions for entertainment, information, or instruction. Responsible for creative decisions, such as interpretation of script, choice of guests, set design, sound, special effects, and choreography.

Knowledge and Skills Needed for this Career

In addition to courses required for high school graduation, essential skills and knowledge needed for a career as producer or director are reinforced by taking rigorous and relevant courses, as well as participating in work-based experiences and student organization activities.
