TELECOMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT INSTALLER

Set-up, rearranges, or removes switching and dialing equipment used in central offices. Service or repair telephones and other communication equipment on customers' property. May install equipment in new locations or install wiring and telephone jacks in buildings under construction.

Knowledge and Skills Needed for this Career

In addition to courses required for high school graduation, essential skills and knowledge needed for a career as a telecommunications equipment installer and repairer are reinforced by taking rigorous and relevant courses, as well as participating in work-based experiences and student organization activities.
