TECHNICAL EDUCATION TEACHER - POSTSECONDARY

Teach or instruct technical or occupational subjects to students who have graduated or left high school, including correspondence school instructors; industrial, commercial and government training instructors; and adult education teachers and instructors. Teaching may take place in public or private schools whose primary business is education or in a school associated with an organization whose primary business is other than education.

Knowledge and Skills Needed

In addition to courses required for high school graduation, essential skills and knowledge needed for a career as a postsecondary career and technical education teacher are reinforced by taking rigorous and relevant courses, as well as participating in work-based experiences and student organization activities.
