- Accounting 1 not required
- Rigorous curriculum
- Take test at end; if pass and go to KSU, receive 3 college credits
- If pass and don't go to KSU, may take webinar class for \$1150 and receive 6 college credits in total

Accounting 2

- Finish Chapters 17-24 in Accounting 1 book
- Do chapters 1-10 in Advanced Accounting book
- Use Quickbooks at the end of each chapter
- Do the simulation at the end of 24 for 1st semester
- Do the simulation at the end of Advanced 10 for 2nd semester

Accounting 3



- Finish Advanced Accounting book 1st semester
- Used Tecknow as final. Can only be done on paper so took a long time
- Implement College Accounting concepts 2nd semester
