

Training Sessions: Navigating Through ePeGS for the NCLB Application

The Federal Programs' funding applications will be available on ePeGS for the 2009-2010 school year. We anticipate opening the funding applications for LEA use on Monday, June 1, 2009. The deadline for submission of the No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Consolidated Application on ePeGS is July 1, 2009.

Although the NCLB law did not change, the look and feel of the consolidated application has changed. Federal Programs' staff will be offering training on entering information into the NCLB Consolidated Application on ePeGS. These training sessions will consist of an overview of the ePeGS funding application tool, highlighting the NCLB requirements such as the Title I Breakdown of Allocation (BOA), transferability options, REAP-flex options, schoolwide program options, and the tracking of ARRA funds. In addition, staff will demonstrate how the planning tool ties to the funding application. Following the presentation, Federal Program staff members will be available to provide assistance as the participants enter their school district information into the NCLB application.

Items needed to complete the NCLB funding application:

1. Participants **must** have their User ID and password in order to access their specific school district's information. We have copied the authority from the current Federal Grants' Application system to the ePeGS system. When the system becomes available on June 1, make sure you have the appropriate security authority. If you need to make changes, the DESE Web Systems User ID Request Form is located at: <https://k12apps.dese.mo.gov/webapps/securityforms/MO500-2377.pdf>
2. A copy of your proposed budgets. The ePeGS system uses the combination of function codes and object codes for budget purposes. Sample budget forms showing the function/object codes for the various program budgets are available at: <http://dese.mo.gov/epegs/FederalProgramsBudgetPages.html>
3. Breakdown of Allocation information. The system copies enrollment and free/reduced lunch data from Core Data screens; however, it is the LEA's responsibility to make sure the information is correct.
4. The budget pages are linked to the planning tool. LEAs should have completed the Goals, Objectives, Strategies, and Action Steps (GOSA) for the various programs.
5. Any other supporting documents to complete the application.
