

Workshop for New Teachers in Gifted Programs

Drury University in Springfield, Mo. – July 27-28, 2009

This workshop is planned especially for teachers with no experience teaching gifted students. Registration is reserved for new teachers, and space is limited.



The workshop will begin at 9 a.m. on July 27 and end at 3 p.m. on July 28. All sessions will be on the second floor at Lay Hall. **Registration is \$80.**
