

Transition Wheel

This visual aid was developed to assist in calculating when a transition meeting is due to ensure that the meeting can be held by the time the child is 2 ½ years old.

Every month is directly across from the month that is 6 months away from it. Find the child's birth month, go directly across the wheel and on the corresponding color is the month in which the meeting is due. The transition meeting will need to be held no later than the date of the child's birthday in the corresponding month. (This can also be used to calculate the date for six month reviews by using the meeting date instead of the child's birth date.)

For example, if the child's birthday is July 11, find July (red) and right across from July, also in red, is January. You know that the transition meeting is due **before** January 11.

If the child's birthday is May 1, the transition meeting is due **before** November 1, which means it needs to be held sometime in October.
