



Final Scenario: Poll Results



- Establish Regional Cooperatives in strategic locations throughout the State and consolidate MSSD's portfolio of schools into fewer/newer buildings.
- Establish Regional Cooperatives in strategic locations throughout the State and gradually phase out all MSSD Schools as the Regional Cooperatives are established.
- Establish Regional Cooperatives in strategic locations throughout the State and preserve as many MSSD schools as possible in the current system.



- Staff Vacancies: 115 Vacant Positions (23%)
- Enrollment Decline: 1,033 to 660 Students in 16 yrs
- **Buildings:** 50+ Years Old / Poor Education Adequacy
- Worker's Compensation: \$500k avg claims/yr
- Leased Buildings: \$320k/yr
- Under-Utilized Space: \$1.4M/yr
- Instruction: No Consistent Measures for Progress Monitoring, Student Outcomes, or Alternate Standards Alignment (DLM)

 Declining Enrollment – Student enrollment continues to decrease, with further declines projected, impacting school resources and sustainability.

 Staffing Shortages – Ongoing staff departures have led to emergency school consolidations to maintain adequate staffing levels. Leadership Instability – High turnover in Superintendent and Assistant Superintendent roles has made it difficult to maintain consistent oversight of MSSD.

 Limited Professional Learning & Support – The geographic spread of schools makes it challenging for leadership to provide regular instructional support and professional development








Statewide: Existing Portfolio


Committee Recommendations – Schools + LEA Collaboratives







ESN Program Support grants would transition a portion of MSSD funding allocations to a grant-based structure. These grants would provide supplemental funds to LEAs and collaboratives to support costs associated with:

- Specialized instructional or curricular materials for students with ESN
- Assessment and evaluation materials
- Specialized equipment, software, or other assistive technologies
- Personnel costs, including contracted staff, to provide direct services, indirect services, and / or case management supports for students who have ESN
- Post-secondary readiness materials to support student transition from K12 to post-school employment, continuing education, community access, or independent living

***These requirements and the following scenarios are hypothetical and for the purposes of illustration only ***

Grant awards are to be determined on a first-come-first-served basis annually. Eligible grant recipients apply indicating the number of students served with qualifying ESN.

LEAs may apply for grant funds for up to **15 qualifying students** with ESN. LEA collaboratives may apply for grant funds for up to **30 qualifying students** with ESN.

Sample Criteria for Qualifying Student with ESN:

- Have a current Individualized Education Program (IEP)
- Be determined eligible to receive special education and related services under the IDEA as a student with Autism Spectrum Disorder, Intellectual Disability, or Multiple Disabilities
- Receive special education and related services at a rate and intensity that requires a student to staff ratio of 4:1 or lower.
- Meet the Missouri state criteria for participation in the state alternate achievement assessment as a student with the <u>most significant cognitive disability</u>.
- Participate in an instructional program based on alternate academic achievement standards
