The Monthly Open Order Form can be found on the DESE – FNS USDA Foods website ([USDA Foods | Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education](#)). The Monthly Open Order USDA Foods may be requested in any quantity which will be used in a timely manner without waste. All Monthly Open Order Forms must be filled out and returned via E-Mail to DESE – FNS at [donatedfoods@dese.mo.gov](mailto:donatedfoods@dese.mo.gov) by the 15<sup>th</sup> of each Month for delivery the following month. Nine monthly deliveries will be made to each LEA beginning in August 2016 through April 2017.

The Annual USDA Foods Packet is filled out annually by each LEA and is due back to DESE – FNS in February to determine the items to be received during the next school year.
