# 2015 Dashboard and Metrics

- **NEW – Simplified dashboard**
  - Includes 5 key student outcome measures, results, progress arrows, and current rank
  
- **REVISED – Current dashboard renamed “Top 10 by 20 Metrics”**
  - Retains the look of current dashboard
  - Contains revisions to a few current metrics (e.g., ACT comparison only to other census administration states)
  - Includes measures related to Top 10 by 20 Goals
  - Moves compliance items to Report Card only
  
- **RETAINED – Report card**
  - Contains information needed for compliance with state and federal reporting requirements
  - Is not hosted on the Top 10 by 20 page of the website



# Outcome Measures for Revised Dashboard

- **NAEP**
  - Grade 4 and grade 8 mathematics and reading
- **MAP**
  - English language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies
- **Four-year graduation rate**
- **Postsecondary placement**
  - Two-year or four-year college or university
  - Postsecondary technical training
  - Employment
  - Military
- **ACT**
  - Percent scoring above the national average
