




# Dashboard

## National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP) Percent of students scoring proficient or advanced




## Four-Year Graduation Rate




## College and Career Readiness Percentage of Missouri students meeting or exceeding state standards\*

# FY16 Key Targets Accomplished To-Date

## Goal 1

- Interim assessments available to all districts and charters
- Materials and tools for MSIP Support and Intervention Plan systems reviews
- On-line training packages: collaborative teams, feedback, assessment capable learners, data-based decision-making, and formative assessment development and use
- VR Pre-Employment Transition Pilot projects with the MU Hook Center



# FY16 Key Targets Accomplished To-Date

## Goal 2

- 100% of districts offering parent education programs
- Waiver to the U.S. Department of Education for blended funding options for early childhood education
- Administrative rule for payment of leased facilities for early learning programs

- State's model evaluation system for teacher candidates
- Draft training materials specific to “instructional leadership”
