New English language arts and mathematics assessments were administered in 2016.


No changes were made to science assessments.

Mathematics and English Language Arts are required in grades 3 – 8.


Science is required in grades 5 and 8.




# Grade-Level Mathematics Proficient and Advanced

# End-of-Course Assessments


End-of-Course assessments remained the same in 2016 as the prior year.

Algebra I, Biology, English II, and Government are required assessments.


Algebra II, American History, English I, Geometry, and Physical Science are optional assessments.






# End-of-Course Mathematics Proficient and Advanced




# End-Of-Course English Language Arts Proficient/Advanced





## English Language Arts




