ORDER OF RULEMAKING

By the authority vested in the State Board of Education (board) under sections 168.011, 168.405, 168.409, 161.092, 168.021, 168.071, 168.081, and 168.400, RSMo Supp. 2011 the board rescinds a rule as follows:

5 CSR 20-400.150 Application for Certificate of License to Teach is **rescinded**.

A notice of proposed rulemaking containing the text of the proposed rescission was published in the Missouri Register on December 2, 2019 (44 MoReg 3023). No Changes have been made in this text of the proposed rescission, so it is not reprinted here. This proposed rescission becomes effective in thirty (30) days after publication in the *Code of State Regulations*.
