ORDER OF RULEMAKING

By the authority vested in the State Board of Education (board) under sections 161.092, 168.021, 168.071, and 168.081, RSMo Supp. 2011, and section 168.011, RSMo 2000 the board rescinds a rule as follows:

5 CSR 20-400.200 Application for an Adult Education and Literacy Certificate of License to Teach **is rescinded.**

A notice of proposed rulemaking containing the text of the proposed rescission was published in the *Missouri Register* on July 1, 2020 (45 MoReg 994). No Changes have been made in the text of the proposed rescission, so it is not reprinted here. This proposed rescission becomes effective in thirty (30) days after publication in the *Code of State Regulations*.
