SUMMARY

This regulation established 1) a requirement that all students shall demonstrate basic educational competencies prior to formal admission into the approved programs in Missouri and 2) procedures for implementation.

This rule is being rescinded because these requirements are included in 5 CSR 20-400.440 Procedures and Standards for Approval and Accreditation of Professional Education Programs in Missouri.

RECOMMENDATION

The Department recommends that the State Board of Education authorize publication in the *Missouri Register* of a notice of proposed rulemaking to rescind 5 CSR 20-400.310, Basic Education Competencies Required Prior to Admission to Approved Teacher Education Programs in Missouri, and that the State Board finds the proposed rescission necessary to carry out the purposes of Sections 161.092, 168.021, 168.400, and 168.011, RSMo.

PROPOSED RESCISSION

5 CSR 20-400.310 Basic Education Competencies Required Prior to Admission to Approved Teacher Education Programs in Missouri.
