SUMMARY:

On February 16, 2016, the State Board of Education approved a notice of proposed rulemaking to amend 5 CSR 20-100.120 Advanced Placement and International Baccalaureate Fee Payment Program. The notice of proposed rulemaking was published in the April 1, 2016, edition of the *Missouri Register* for comment. No comments were received during the 30-day comment period.

The Advanced Placement fee reimbursement program is a federal grant program that helps pay for a portion of AP and IB exam costs. The proposed changes to this rule update the language of the rule to be consistent with current practice.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department recommends that the State Board of Education authorize publication in the *Missouri Register* of an order of rulemaking to amend rule 5 CSR 20-100.120 relating to Advanced Placement and International Baccalaureate Fee Payment Program, and that the State Board finds this amendment necessary to carry out the purposes of Sections 161.092 and 178.430, RSMo.

ORDER OF RULEMAKING

By the authority vested in the State Board of Education under section 161.092, RSMo Supp. 2014, and 178.430, RSMo 2000, the board amends as follows:

5 CSR 20-100.120 Advanced Placement and International Baccalaureate Fee Payment Program
is **amended**.

A notice of proposed rulemaking containing the text of the proposed amendment was published in the *Missouri Register* on April 1, 2016 (41 MoReg 443-444). No changes have been made in the text of the proposed amendment, so it is not reprinted here. This proposed amendment becomes effective thirty (30) days after publication in the *Code of State Regulations*.
