Accreditation Determinations

- Classification may not be lowered based on assessment outcomes in years when standards change. (Section 161.855, RSMo, 4.)

Accreditation Determinations

- Classification may be changed for:
 - failure to implement required school improvement plan;
 - significant change in student performance over multiple years;
 - employed a Superintendent/CEO without a valid Missouri Superintendent certificate;
 - significant change in the scope or effectiveness of the programs, services, or financial integrity upon which the original classification designation was based; and/or
 - failure to comply with statute.

- Public hearing to review changes to Scoring Guide

Classification of School Districts

- Three (3) consecutive years to inform district classification recommendations
- Utilize 2013, 2014 and 2015 APRs
- Timeline for classification:
 - November, 2015 – January, 2016
