The Annual Performance Report for Educator Preparation Programs (APR-EPP) is included in the Missouri Standards for the Preparation of Educators (MoSPE). The goals of this system of accountability provides:

1. Continuous Improvement of Educator Preparation Programs
2. Annual Data on Quality of Programs to the Public
3. Accreditation of Certification Areas by Educator Preparation Programs

The Annual Performance Report will be reported by certification program area, including 137 programs for teachers, 7 programs for school counselors, and 45 programs for school leaders. The reports provide the platform for continuous improvement for each certification area and to ensure transparency to the public on the performance of Educator Preparation Programs to all stakeholders in Missouri.




137 Reportable Teacher Certification Programs (*n*-size of 10 or more Candidates)








7 Reportable Counselor Certification Programs (*n*-size of 10 or more Candidates)
