Terms

Min = Lowest score – Scores between Min and Q1 are between the 1st and 24th Percentile.

Q1 = Quartile 1 – Scores between Q1 and Median are between the 25th and 49th Percentile

Median – Median – Scores between the Median and Q3 are between the 50th and 74th Percentile.

Q3 – Quartile 3 – Scores between Q3 and Max are between the 75th and 99th Percentile.

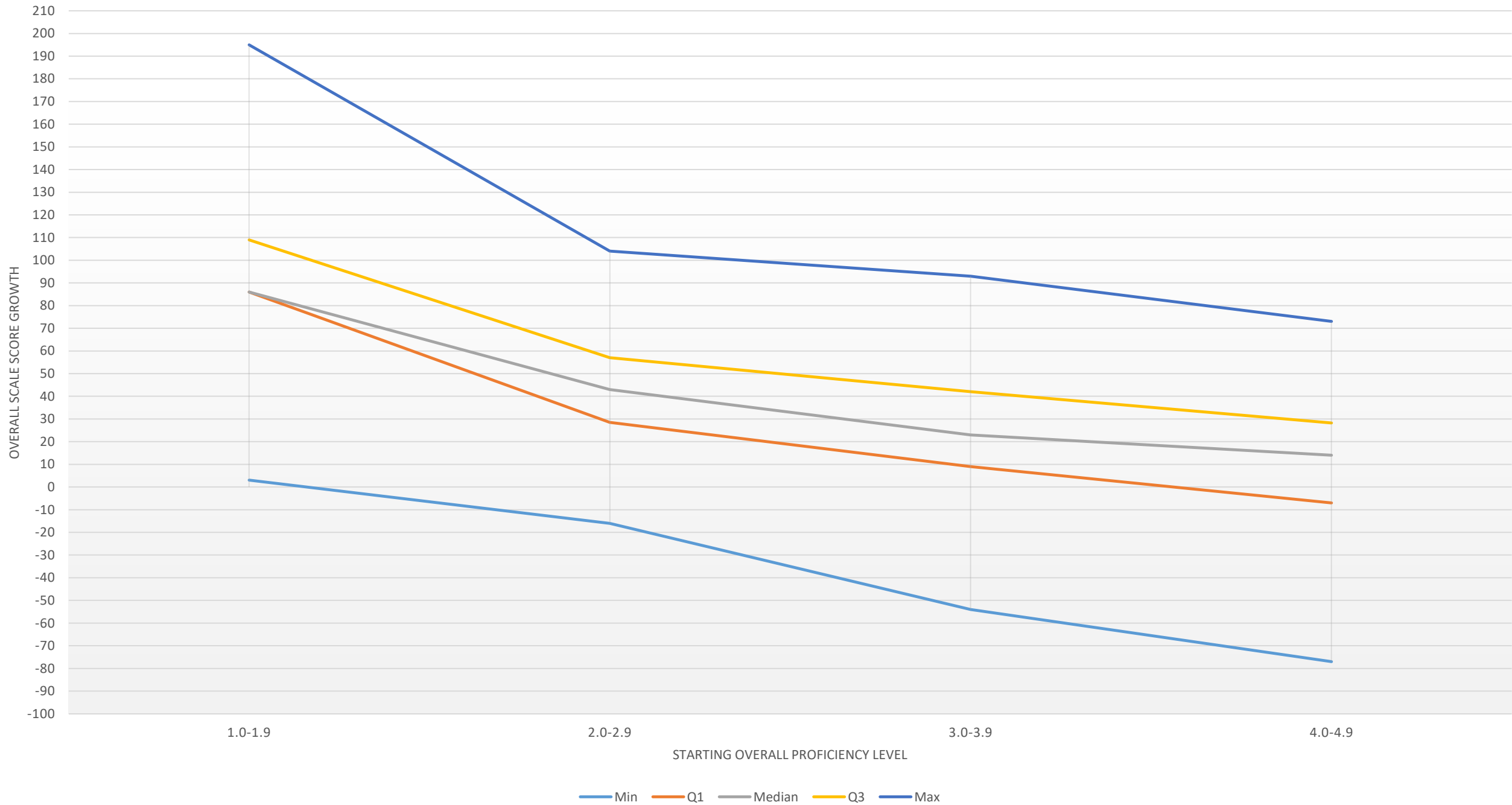
Max – Highest score in Missouri

Directions

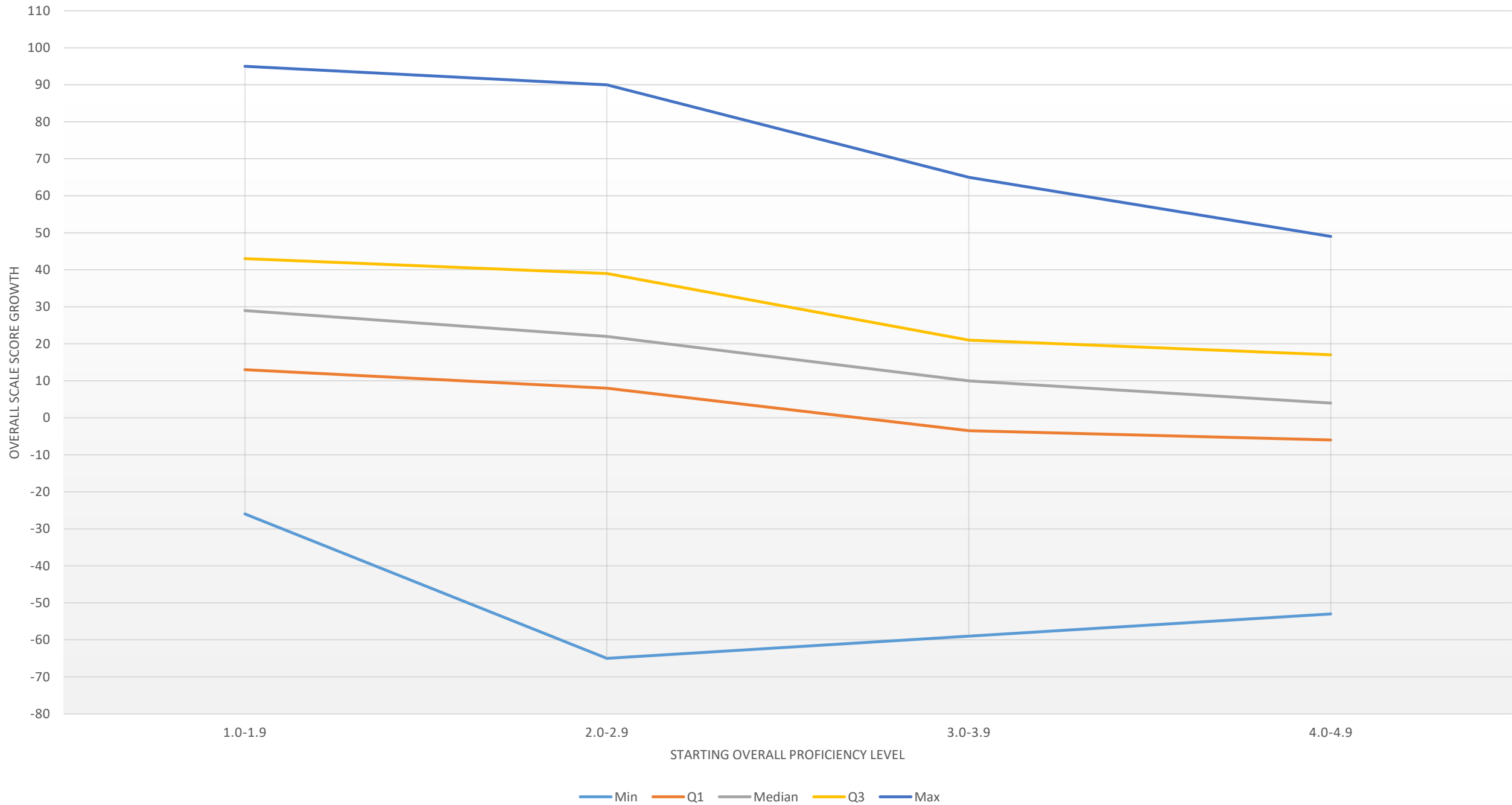
The purpose of these charts is to see where your students are related to other ELs in Missouri by grade level and starting proficiency level. This process is intended to make “apples to apples” comparisons between students. From this work, you can analyze the effectiveness of a school’s support program for individual students, students at specific proficiency levels and entire grade levels. To do this work, simply find the difference between the overall scale scores from 2017 and 2018 and plot that number on the chart. Use the students beginning PL (from 2017) to determine where on the horizontal axis to plot the number.
