 - i. MACCE recommended discontinuing the issuance of Unified Science Certificates
 - ii. Presented to State Board of Education (SBE) December 2018
 - iii. Public comment ends April 1, 2019
 - b. Substitute Certificate
 - i. Rule changes were presented to SBE in March 2019

- ii. The rule change was accepted as written
 - iii. Rule-making process takes approximately 7-9 months
 - c. Computer Science K-12 Certificate
 - i. Add on certificate only
 - ii. Added by passing computer science content assessment
 - iii. Available 7/1/2019
 - d. Literacy Requirements
 - i. New Literacy requirements were approved by SBE
 - ii. The requirements will become effective August 1, 2019
 - e. Principal Certificate-proposed rule changes
 - i. New name: School Leader K-12
 - ii. Amends requirements to align with current Professional Standards for Education Leaders (PSEL)
 - iii. Replaces principal K-8, 5-9, and 7-12 certificates

 - b. Discussion was held.
 - c. Kathy Steinhoff suggesting adding coursework addressing cultural responsiveness.
 - d. Allison O'very made the motion to accept rewritten terms of the Temporary Authorization Certificate to include cultural proficiency to item E in number 13 of proposed rule changes. Nicole Nickens seconded the motion. Motion carried by a vote of 15 in favor; none opposed.

9. Additional Certificate Subcommittee Update-Nicole Nickens
 - a. Nicole Nickens provided a handout of the survey results for the additional certificate.
 - b. Discussion was held.
 - c. Paula York made the motion to remove the Library Media Specialist K-12 certificate as a certificate that may be added by passing a content assessment. Tresina Alvested seconded the motion. Motion failed by a vote of 4 in favor; 10 opposed.
 - d. Paula York would like to review the Library Media Specialist certificate as an area that may be added by assessment at the September meeting.
 - e. Jacqueline McGill asked that someone from Missouri Association of School Librarians (MASL) provide additional information on the Library Media Specialist certificate.
