Required Assessments

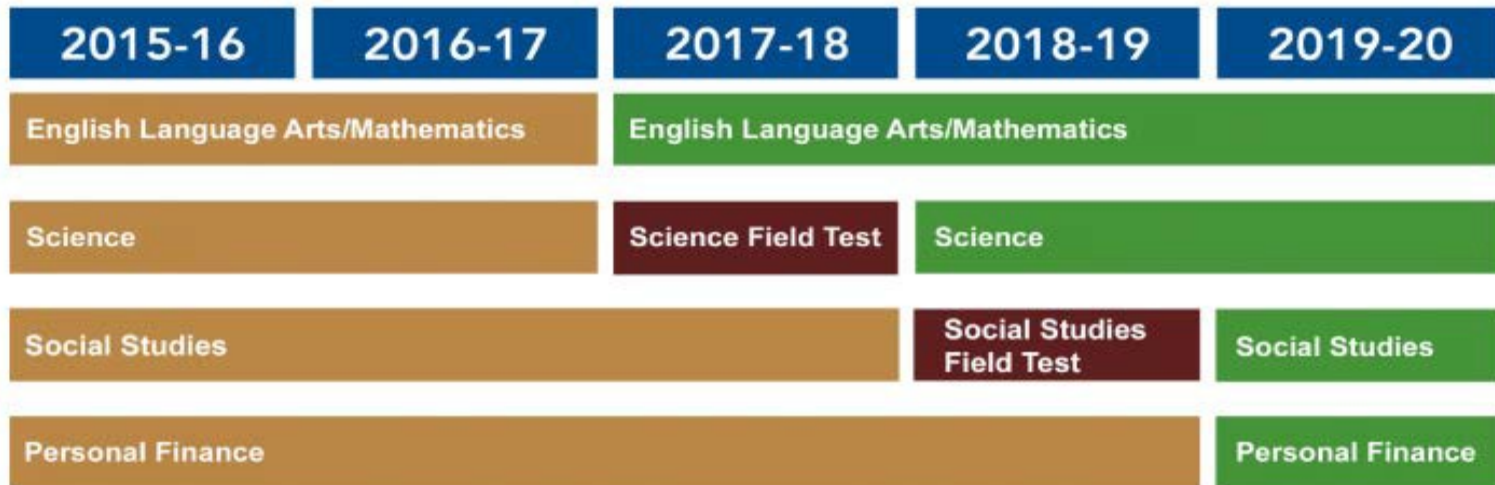
Assessment	Authorization	Timing Guidelines*
GLA ELA and Mathematics (grades 3-8)	Required by ESSA	90-250 min
GLA Science (grades 5 and 8)	Required by ESSA	90-150 min
EOC Algebra I, Biology, English II	Required by ESSA	180-220 min
EOC American Government	Required by MSIP 5	60-80 min
EOC Algebra II, American History, English I, Geometry, Personal Finance, Physical Science	Optional	180-220 min

*Estimated time necessary to complete a single assessment. Missouri assessments are not timed. Maximum time on testing occurs in grade 8 and represents less than .9% of total instructional time.



Implementation Schedule

On May 17, 2016, the Missouri State Board of Education approved a schedule for implementing assessments aligned to the newly adopted expectations. Initial operational administration of new English language arts and mathematics assessments will take place in the 2017-2018 school year, followed by science in 2018-2019 (field testing to occur in 2017-2018 school year) and social studies in 2019-2020 (field testing to occur in 2018-2019 school year). The figure below illustrates the implementation schedule.

Assessment

- 2018-19
- Science, first operational year, scores available in Fall 2019
- English I and English II, listening items field test
- Social Studies, stand-alone field test, new MLS, no scores or reports
- Personal Finance operational test, previous MLS and field testing, new MLS
