DEPARTMENT GOAL NO. 3:

Missouri will prepare, develop, and support effective educators.

SUMMARY:

April Bash holds a content substitute certificate of license to teach, effective October 1, 2013, with an expiration date of October 1, 2017. No evidence was presented in regard to Ms. Bash’s teaching status.

On October 24, 2014, Ms. Bash pled guilty and received a suspended imposition of sentence (SIS). Ms. Bash also pled guilty and received a suspended execution of sentence (SES) to the Misdemeanor, DWI. Ms. Bash was placed on two years of unsupervised probation.

Ms. Bash was neither present at the hearing, nor was she represented through counsel.

RECOMMENDATION:
