DEPARTMENT GOAL NO. 1:

All Missouri students will graduate college and career ready.

SUMMARY:

In 2013, the Interim Career and Technical Education (CTE) Advisory Committee was convened. The purpose of the Interim CTE Advisory Committee was to provide input and recommendations to the Department on issues that affect secondary, postsecondary and adult CTE programs and services.

The interim committee was made up of representatives from area career centers, comprehensive high schools, community colleges, State Technical College of Missouri, and four-year universities. The committee met quarterly or as needed.

Due to the passage of SB 620 & 582, the work of the CTE Interim Advisory Committee will transition to a new Career and Technical Education Advisory Council upon completion of pending appointments.

SB620 – CTE Advisory Council

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- **CTE Advisory Council** composed of 15 members with 11 being appointed by the Commissioner of Education.
 - Director of an area career center;
 - An individual from the business community;
 - A representative from State Technical College of MO;
 - Three current or retired CTE teachers who also serve or served as an advisor to any of the nationally-recognized CTSOs;
 - A representative from a business organization, association of businesses or a business coalition;



SB620 – CTE Advisory Council (Cont.)

- A representative from a Missouri community college;
- A representative from SEMO or UCM;
- An individual participating in an apprenticeship recognize by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations;
- A school administrator or school superintendent of a school that offers CTE.
- Also to include four members from the General Assembly:
 - Two from House of Representatives
 - Two from Senate



SB620 – CTE Advisory Council (Cont.)

- Three non-voting Ex Officio Members:
 - DESE Director of School Counseling
 - Director of the Division of Workforce Development
 - A member of the Coordinating Board for Higher Education, as selected by the Coordinating Board
