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**DEPARTMENT GOAL NO. 3:**

Missouri will prepare, develop, and support effective educators.

**SUMMARY:**

Tena Cady, Respondent, holds a career professional class certificate in the area of learning disabled, grades K to 9, which expires June 8, 2104.

In January 2013, in the Circuit Court of Lawrence County, a jury found Respondent guilty of two felony counts of attempt to manufacture a controlled substance. Respondent was sentenced to 12 years in the Department of Corrections.

Respondent received notice of a hearing on this matter, but was not present either personally or through counsel.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the State Board of Education revoke Respondent's teaching certificate pursuant to its authority under Mo. Rev. Stat. § 168.071 (Supp. 2013).

Introduction

This matter was held on September 9, 2014, before Cynthia Quetsch, Hearing Officer, designated by the Commissioner of Education. Those present were:

- Faraz Nayyar, Counsel for the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education;
- Margery Tanner, Director for Educator Certification, Department of Elementary and Secondary Education; and
- Dana Keilholz, Legal Assistant, Department of Elementary and Secondary Education

Findings of Fact

1. Tena Cady, Respondent, holds a career professional class certificate in the area of learning disabled, grades K to 9, issued on June 8, 2005, which expires June 8, 2104. (Petitioner’s Exhibit 3) (Transcript page 13, line 19 to page 14, line 5).
2. On or about January 11, 2013, a jury found Respondent guilty of two felony counts of attempt to manufacture a controlled substance in violation of Mo. Rev. Stat. § 195.211 in the circuit court of Lawrence County, Missouri. Respondent was sentenced to 12 years in the Department of Corrections. (Petitioner’s Exhibits 4, 5, and 7).
3. On September 9, 2014, a hearing was held before Cynthia Quetsch, Hearing Officer. Respondent was not present and was not represented by counsel. Petitioner was represented by Assistant Attorney General Faraz Nayyar. (Transcript page 5, line 25 to page 6, line 3).
4. Respondent received notice of the hearing by letter dated July 2, 2014, sent to the last known address of Respondent, both by certified mail and first-class mail. The certified mail was signed for by Janice Hunt. Respondent’s address was the Chillicothe Correction Center. (Petitioner’s Exhibits 1 and 2) (Transcript page 8, line 5 to page 11, line 8).

### Conclusions of Law

1. Respondent, was convicted of two felony counts of attempt to manufacture a controlled substance in circuit court in violation of Mo. Rev. Stat. §195.211.
2. The charges concerning Respondent's current teaching certificate were set for hearing and notice was served on the Respondent in compliance with the requirements of Mo. Rev. Stat. § 536.067 (Supp. 2013).
3. Mo. Rev. Stat. § 168.071.1 (1) (Supp. 2013) provides the following authority to the State Board of Education:

*The state board of education may refuse to issue or renew a certificate, or may, upon hearing, discipline the holder of a certificate of license to teach for the following causes: (1) A certificate holder or applicant for a certificate has pleaded to or been found guilty of a felony or crime involving moral turpitude under the laws of this state, any other state, of the United States, or any other country, whether or not sentence is imposed;*

4. The Missouri Supreme Court has defined "moral turpitude" as:


*An act of baseness, vileness, or depravity in the private and social duties which man owes to his fellowman or to society in general, contrary to the accepted and customary rule of right and duty between man and man; everything 'done contrary to justice, honesty, modesty and good morals'. In re Frick, 694 S.W.2d 473, 479 (Mo. banc 1985).*

5. Respondent was convicted of two felonies by a jury.
6. Attempt to manufacture a controlled substance is a crime of moral turpitude. *Brehe v. Mo. Dept. of Elem. & Sec. Ed*, 213 S.W.3d 720, 725 (Mo. App. W.D. 2007).
7. Based upon Mo. Rev. Stat. §168.071.1(1) (Supp. 2013) the State Board of Education is authorized to suspend or revoke any certificate held by Respondent.

### Recommendation

It is recommended that the State Board of Education revoke the certificate of license to teach of Tena Cady pursuant to its authority under Mo. Rev. Stat. § 168.071 (Supp. 2013).

1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 HEARING OFFICER QUETSCH: This hearing  
3 is in the matter of the Department of Elementary and  
4 Secondary Education versus Tena Cady and has been  
5 designated Hearing 14-034.

6 This hearing is being held pursuant to  
7 168.071 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, which  
8 authorizes the State Board of a Education to suspend  
9 or revoke a certificate of license to teach if the  
10 certificate holder has pleaded to or been found  
11 guilty of a felony or crime involving moral  
12 turpitude under the laws of this state or any other  
13 state of the United States or any other country  
14 whether or not sentence is imposed.

15 Administrative rules adopted by the State  
16 Board of Education pursuant to this statute  
17 authorizes the Commissioner of Education to  
18 designate a hearing officer in these matters. My  
19 name is Cynthia Quetsch and I have been designated  
20 to hear this case.

21 Unless otherwise provided under Section  
22 168.071, this hearing is being held pursuant to the  
23 procedural rules of Chapter 537, the Administrative  
24 Procedure Act.

25 The certificate holder, Tena Cady, is not

1 present at this hearing and is not represented by  
2 counsel. Assistant attorney general Faraz Nayyar is  
3 present on behalf of the State.

4 Mr. Nayyar, am I pronouncing that right?

5 MR. NAYYAR: It's Faraz.

6 HEARING OFFICER QUETSCH: Faraz?

7 MR. NAYYAR: Yes.

8 HEARING OFFICER QUETSCH: Okay. What is  
9 your last name?

10 MR. NAYYAR: Nayyar.

11 HEARING OFFICER QUETSCH: Nayyar, okay.

12 Would you like to give an opening  
13 statement?

14 MR. NAYYAR: Yes, I have a short opening  
15 statement. Ms. Cady currently holds a Career CPC  
16 Certificate of License to teach children with  
17 learning disabilities grades K through nine.

18 On January 11th, 2013, a jury found Ms. Cady  
19 guilty of two Class B felony counts. One was  
20 attempting to manufacture methamphetamines and the  
21 second was attempting to manufacture over 5 grams of  
22 marijuana.

23 This was in violation of Section 195.211 RSMO  
24 2013. Ms. Cady was sentenced to five years and  
25 twelve years of imprisonment to be served

1 concurrently at the Department of Corrections. She  
2 is currently serving her sentence.

3 And cause exists to discipline Ms. Cady's  
4 certificate pursuant to Section 168.071.1 Subsection  
5 1 RSMO 2013 and 5 CSR 20-400.230 Subsection 1A,  
6 and 5 CSR 20-400.230, Subsection 8.

7 We ask that the board discipline respondent's  
8 license as it deems appropriate.

9 HEARING OFFICER QUETSCH: You can call  
10 your first witness.

11 MR. NAYYAR: We call Dana Keilholz.

12 (Whereupon, the witness was sworn in by  
13 the court reporter.)

14 EXAMINATION

15 QUESTIONS BY MR. NAYYAR:

16 **Q. Can you please state your full name and**  
17 **spell your last name for the record?**

18 A. Dana Keilholz. K-E-I-L-H-O-L-Z.

19 **Q. Are you currently employed?**

20 A. Yes, I am.

21 **Q. Where are you employed?**

22 A. I work for the Department of Elementary  
23 and Secondary Education as legal assistant.

24 **Q. And how long have you worked for the**  
25 **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education?**

1 A. Over 20 years.

2 **Q. What are your primary job duties?**

3 A. As legal assistant I set up and identify  
4 the appropriate parties for discipline hearings.

5 **Q. And did you send a notice to Ms. Tena**  
6 **Cady?**

7 A. Yes, I did.

8 **Q. And I have already handed you Exhibit**  
9 **1 -- I'm going to hand you Exhibit 1.**

10 **So do you recognize Exhibit 1?**

11 A. I do.

12 **Q. And what is it?**

13 A. It is the notice of the hearing that was  
14 set for ten o'clock today and includes a copy of the  
15 complaint and also the statutory regulations that it  
16 was held for.

17 **Q. And is this a true and accurate copy of**  
18 **the notice of disciplinary hearing sent to Ms. Cady?**

19 A. Yes.

20 **Q. And does the department maintain these**  
21 **documents as records?**

22 A. Yes.

23 **Q. And was this document made in the**  
24 **ordinary course of business by a person with**  
25 **relevant knowledge and information as to the**

1 **hearings?**

2 A. Yes.

3 **Q. And was this document made at or near**  
4 **the time the notice was sent?**

5 A. Yes.

6 MR. NAYYAR: I offer Exhibit 1 into  
7 evidence.

8 HEARING OFFICER QUETSCH: It is  
9 received.

10 **Q. (MR. NAYYAR) And how was this notice**  
11 **sent to Ms. Cady?**

12 A. I sent it first class mail and also  
13 certified mail return receipt requested.

14 **Q. And do you have Exhibit 2 in front of**  
15 **you?**

16 A. Yes.

17 **Q. And what is Exhibit 2?**

18 A. Exhibit 2 is a copy of the file that I  
19 keep that shows that the certified mail was signed  
20 accepted by Janice Hunt on July 7th, 2014.

21 **Q. And is this a true and accurate copy of**  
22 **the certified mail receipt received by you regarding**  
23 **the notice?**

24 A. Yes.

25 **Q. And does the department maintain these**

1 documents as records?

2 A. Yes.

3 Q. And was this document made in the  
4 ordinary course of business by a person with  
5 relevant knowledge and information as to the  
6 hearings?

7 A. Yes.

8 Q. And was this document made at or near  
9 the time the notice was sent out?

10 A. Yes.

11 MR. NAYYAR: I offer Exhibit 2 into  
12 evidence.

13 HEARING OFFICER QUETSCH: It is  
14 received.

15 Q. (MR. NAYYAR) What was the address on  
16 the certified receipt?

17 A. It went to Tena Cady with her number to  
18 the Chillicothe Correctional Center at 3151 Litton  
19 Road, Chillicothe, Missouri 64601.

20 Q. And what happened with the certified  
21 mail?

22 A. It was received and the green card was  
23 returned to us.

24 Q. Was it signed?

25 A. Yes.

1 Q. When was it signed?

2 A. July 7th, 2014.

3 Q. And was the notice also sent first class  
4 mail?

5 A. Yes, it was.

6 Q. And did that first class mail come back  
7 as undeliverable?

8 A. No.

9 MR. NAYYAR: I have no other questions.

10 HEARING OFFICER QUETSCH: Call your next  
11 witness.

12 MR. NAYYAR: I call Margery Tanner.

13 (Whereupon, the witness was sworn in by  
14 the court reporter.)

15 EXAMINATION

16 QUESTIONS BY MR. NAYYAR:

17 Q. Ms. Tanner, do you have Exhibit 3 in  
18 front of you?

19 A. Yes, I do.

20 Q. Before we get into Exhibit 3, can you  
21 please state your full name and spell your last name  
22 for the record?

23 A. Margery Tanner. M-A-R-G-E-R-Y,  
24 T-A-N-N-E-R.

25 Q. And are you currently employed?

1 A. Yes, I am.

2 **Q. Where are you employed?**

3 A. The Department of Elementary and  
4 Secondary Education.

5 **Q. What is your title?**

6 A. I'm the director for educator  
7 certification.

8 **Q. And how long have you worked with the**  
9 **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education?**

10 A. Twenty years.

11 **Q. And what are your primary job duties?**

12 A. I license educators for the State of  
13 Missouri.

14 **Q. And do these duties include maintaining**  
15 **teacher certification records?**

16 A. Yes.

17 **Q. Do you have Exhibit 3 in front of you?**

18 A. Yes, I do.

19 **Q. Do you recognize it?**

20 A. Yes.

21 **Q. What is it?**

22 A. This is a certification record for Tena  
23 Cady.

24 **Q. Is this a true and accurate copy of**  
25 **Ms. Cady's certificate status and staff assignment**

1 report with the exception of the social security  
2 number which has been redacted?

3 A. Yes.

4 Q. Does the department maintain these  
5 documents as records?

6 A. Yes.

7 Q. Was this document made in the ordinary  
8 course of business by a person with relevant  
9 knowledge and information as to the certification  
10 and staff assignments of Ms. Cady?

11 A. Yes.

12 Q. Was this document made at or near the  
13 time of the events that it records?

14 A. Yes.

15 MR. NAYYAR: I offer Exhibit 3 into  
16 evidence.

17 HEARING OFFICER QUETSCH: It is  
18 received.

19 Q. (MR. NAYYAR) And does Ms. Cady hold a  
20 teaching certificate?

21 A. Yes, she does.

22 Q. What type of certificate does she hold?

23 A. She holds a Career CPC Certificate for  
24 the area of learning disabled, grades K through  
25 nine.

1           **Q.   And what is the status of that**  
2 **certificate?**

3           A.   It's current and active.

4           **Q.   When does it expire?**

5           A.   It expires June 8th, 2104.

6           **Q.   When was the last time that Ms. Cady**  
7 **taught?**

8           A.   The last time she was reported as  
9 working was in the '05-'06 school year.

10           MR. NAYYAR:  I have no further  
11 questions.

12           HEARING OFFICER QUETSCH:  You're  
13 excused.

14           MR. NAYYAR:  At this time I would like  
15 to offer Exhibits 4, 5, 6 and 7, which are redacted  
16 certified records regarding the January 11th, 2013,  
17 jury verdict finding Ms. Cady guilty of two Class B  
18 felony counts of attempting to manufacture  
19 methamphetamines and attempting to manufacture over  
20 5 grams of to marijuana in violation of Section  
21 195.211 RSMO2013.

22           The records include a docket sheet, complaint  
23 and sentence and judgment record along with other  
24 certified documents.

25           HEARING OFFICER QUETSCH:  Did you say

1 they were redacted?

2 MR. NAYYAR: Just the social security  
3 number.

4 HEARING OFFICER QUETSCH: They're all  
5 received. Did you have anything else you want to  
6 offer?

7 MR. NAYYAR: No.

8 HEARING OFFICER QUETSCH: Did you want  
9 to make a closing statement?

10 MR. NAYYAR: I have a short closing  
11 statement.

12 HEARING OFFICER QUETSCH: Okay.

13 MR. NAYYAR: Cause exists to discipline  
14 Ms. Cady's certificate pursuant to Section 168.071.1  
15 Subsection 1 RSMO 2013 and 5 CSR 20-400.230 1A and 5  
16 CSR 20-400.230 Subsection 8.

17 Here Ms. Cady was clearly found guilty of two  
18 serious felonies and we would also argue that  
19 attempting to manufacture methamphetamines and over  
20 5 grams of marijuana are crimes of moral turpitude.

21 For these reasons we ask that the board  
22 discipline Ms. Cady's license as it deems  
23 appropriate.

24 HEARING OFFICER QUETSCH: Anything  
25 further?

1 MR. NAYYAR: No.

2 HEARING OFFICER QUETSCH: That would  
3 conclude the hearing. Thank you very much.

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





COMPLAINT

Petitioner, the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, by and through counsel, the Missouri Attorney General, states the following for its cause of action:

1. The Department of Elementary and Secondary Education ("the Department") is an agency of the State of Missouri, created and established pursuant to § 161.020, RSMo,<sup>1</sup> for the purpose of administering and enforcing the provisions of Chapters 161 and 168, RSMo, governing public school personnel, including teachers and others.

<sup>1</sup> All statutory citations are to the 2000 Missouri Revised Statutes as amended unless otherwise indicated.

2. Respondent, Tena D. Cady (“Cady”), currently holds a career CPC certificate of license (“Certificate”) to teach children with learning disabilities, grades K through 9.

3. Cady’s Certificate was issued by the Department on June 8, 2005. Cady’s Certificate is, and was at all relevant times, current and valid.

4. Jurisdiction and venue are proper before the Missouri State Board of Education (the “Board”) pursuant to § 168.071, RSMo Cum. Supp. 2013, and State Regulation 5 CSR 20-400.230.

5. Section 168.071.1, RSMo Cum. Supp. 2013, authorizes the Board to discipline a certificate if the certificate holder has pleaded to or been found guilty of a felony or crime involving moral turpitude. Section 168.071, RSMo Cum. Supp. 2013, states, in part:

1. The state board of education may refuse to issue or renew a certificate, or may, upon hearing, discipline the holder of a certificate of license to teach for the following causes:

(1) A certificate holder or applicant for a certificate has pleaded to or been found guilty of a felony or crime involving moral turpitude under the laws of this state, any other state, of the United States, or any other country, whether or not sentence is imposed[.]

6. State Regulation 5 CSR 20-400.230, provides, in part:

(1) The State Board of Education (the board) may discipline, refuse to issue, or renew a certificate

of license to teach for any one (1) or combination of the following:

- (A) An individual has pled guilty or been found guilty of a felony or crime involving moral turpitude whether or not sentence is imposed[.]

\*\*\*\*\*

- (8) The board may suspend or revoke for a specified time, or indefinitely, a certificate of license to teach pursuant to the rules promulgated by the board.

7. On or about January 11, 2013, Cady was found guilty of two class B felony counts of Attempting to Manufacture a Controlled Substance, in violation of § 195.211, RSMo Cum Supp. 2013.

8. Section 195.211, RSMo Cum. Supp. 2013, states in pertinent part:

1. Except as authorized by sections 195.005 to 195.425 and except as provided in section 195.222, it is unlawful for any person to distribute, deliver, manufacture, produce or attempt to distribute, deliver, manufacture or produce a controlled substance or to possess with intent to distribute, deliver, manufacture, or produce a controlled substance.



3. Any person who violates or attempts to violate this section with respect to any controlled substance except five grams or less of marijuana is guilty of a class B felony.

9. Cady's guilty verdict of two counts of a class B felony, constitutes cause to discipline her Certificate pursuant to § 168.071.1(1), RSMo Cum. Supp. 2013; 5 CSR 20-400.230(1)(A); and 5 CSR 20-400.230 (8).

Based upon the foregoing, the Department prays the Missouri State Board of Education to conduct a hearing pursuant to Chapter 168, RSMo, and thereafter issue its findings of fact and conclusions of law determining that Cady's Certificate to teach be disciplined and for such other and further relief as is deemed just and proper.

The facts that support a finding of probable cause to believe crime(s) was/were committed and that the accused committed the crime(s) are as follows: On Wednesday, October 20, 2010, at approximately 2200 hours, I initiated a knock and talk type investigation at 6464 Lawrence 1200 incident to receiving information the owners at that address were involved in drug activity. Upon my arrival I pulled up to a large metal shop building. As I exited my car I could smell a strong chemical odor which I associated with the manufacture of methamphetamine. I knocked on the door to the shop building and asked, "Joe are you in there?" A voice responded, "Right here." I identified myself and asked the subject to step outside. Upon doing so, I could hear the scurry of feet and realized the subject was running away. Believing the existence of exigent circumstance, I opened the shop door in an effort to secure the site and prevent the destruction of evidence. Once inside I was overwhelmed by a strong chemical odor and saw chemicals that I immediately recognized as components of a methamphetamine laboratory. After the arrest of the fleeing subject, Dennis G. Grider Jr., the property owner, Tena D. Cady returned home. At approximately 2325 hours I told Mrs. Cady she was under arrest and informed her of her Miranda rights. After having been informed of her rights, Mrs. Cady admitted knowledge of the marijuana plants which she stated were being tended to by her husband "Joe". Shortly after Mrs. Cady's arrival, Cpl. D.E. Heil #1258, a narcotics investigator assigned to the Division of Drug and Crime Control, arrived. Cpl. Heil interviewed Mrs. Cady and obtained written consent from each, Mrs. Cady and her two sons, to search the residence, shop building and surrounding property. During the consensual search of the property, we discovered a methamphetamine manufacturing operation in the shop building consisting of the following components: Coleman fuel, Acetone, Heet, an active Anhydrous Ammonia generator, four containers of pill wash, four boxes of pseudoephedrine pills, two packs of dry ice, lithium batteries, six bags of ammonium sulfate, two hot plates, four cans of ether, two bottles of drain opener, a large quantity of small plastic bags, four bottles of rubbing alcohol, plastic hose, clear baking dishes, two glass pipes with methamphetamine residue and miscellaneous pills. We also located 33 marijuana plants being cultivated in a garden adjacent the shop building. Evidence specific to Mrs. Cady's involvement with marijuana was identified during the search of the residence when Mrs. Cady led Cpl. Heil to locations within her home where she had secreted marijuana. Furthermore, Mrs. Cady admitted regular use of the drug.


