DEPARTMENT GOAL NO. 3:

Missouri will prepare, develop, and support effective educators.

SUMMARY:

Ashley B. Campbell holds a career continuous professional certificate of license to teach in the areas of Elementary Education, grades 1–6 and Mild-Moderate Cross Categorical, grades K–12.

Prior to her resignation from Liberty 53 School District in June 2014, Ms. Campbell was employed as a special education teacher and track coach at Liberty North High School.

Ms. Campbell allowed students not assigned to her to spend time in her classroom during the school day rather than in their assigned classes, texted certain students about her personal life, provided transportation to a student without appropriate permission, provided massages to students at track practice, and gave unethical and inappropriate academic assistance to a student by allowing him unauthorized administrative access to the district’s online software system.

Ms. Campbell was neither present at the hearing nor was she represented through counsel.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department recommends that the State Board of Education revoke Ms. Campbell’s certificate pursuant to its authority under Mo. Rev. Stat. § 168.071 (2016).
