



Certified eMINTS Educators

The [eMINTS National Center](#) provides comprehensive research-based professional development services to help teachers integrate technology into their teaching using an instructional model that supports high-quality lesson design, promotes authentic learning, creates technology-rich learning environments, and builds community among students and teachers.

Educators who complete program requirements receive eMINTS certification for the following programs: Comprehensive eMINTS Teachers, eMINTS4All Teachers, and Professional Development for Educational Technology Specialists (PD4ETS). The certification process helps identify and recognize educators who complete their intensive two-year professional development programs and meet all program requirements that include an electronic portfolio review. Certification is performance-based and indicates the individual has demonstrated the knowledge, skills, and abilities to implement the eMINTS Instructional Model.

The listings of Certified eMINTS Educators are updated each fall and provided to the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education for posting/dissemination. There is a separate document for each program. Each program document lists the participant's name, date of program certification, and the district or other organization in which the participant was employed at the time of certification. Note that designations may change as participants move, change district or organization affiliation, or retire.
