<p>This rule established policies and procedures for the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) to evaluate charter sponsors as authorized in Section 160.400.14, RSMo.</p> <p>This rule is being rescinded following State Board of Education approval of sponsorship standards as part of a revision to 5 CSR 20-100.260, Standards for Charter Sponsorship in 2019.</p>

**PROPOSED RESCISSION**

**5 CSR 20-100.250 Charter Schools.** This rule provided policies for evaluating charter school sponsors.

*PURPOSE: This rule is being rescinded because the standards for evaluating charter school sponsors have been incorporated into 5 CSR 20-100.260, Standards for Charter Sponsorship.*

*AUTHORITY: section 160.400 and 161.092, RSMo Supp.2011 and section 2(A) of Art. IX, Mo. Const. Original rule filed January 24, 2012, effective August 30, 2012.*

*PUBLIC COST: This proposed rescission will not cost state agencies or political subdivisions more than five hundred (\$500) in the aggregate.*

*PRIVATE COST: The proposed rescission will not cost private entities more than five hundred dollars (\$500) in the aggregate.*
