<p>DEPARTMENT GOAL NO. 3:</p> <p>Missouri will prepare, develop, and support effective educators.</p> <p>SUMMARY:</p> <p>Kristin Dabney holds a lifetime certificate of license to teach in the area of Physical Education, grades K–12. Ms. Dabney also held a substitute certificate that expired on August 1, 2014. Ms. Dabney is not currently teaching in a Missouri public school.</p> <p>On April 13, 2015, Ms. Dabney pled guilty and received a suspended imposition of sentence (SIS) to the Felony, Theft/Stealing (Value of Property or Services is \$500 or More but Less than \$25,000). Ms. Dabney obtained money from the Missouri Division of Employment Security through deceit by telling the Missouri Division of Employment Security that she earned less money than she actually had in order to obtain a larger unemployment benefit to which she was actually entitled. Ms. Dabney was placed on five years of supervised probation and ordered to pay restitution.</p> <p>Ms. Dabney received notice of the hearing, but was neither present nor represented through counsel.</p> <p>PRESENTER:</p> <p>William R. Thornton, General Counsel, will participate in the presentation and discussion of this agenda item.</p> <p>RECOMMENDATION:</p> <p>The Department recommends that the State Board of Education revoke Ms. Dabney’s teaching certificate pursuant to its authority under Mo. Rev. Stat. § 168.071 (Supp. 2014).</p>
