SUMMARY:
 Charles C. Deem, Respondent, holds a lifetime certificate of license to teach in the area of physical education, grades 7-12. His certification is current and active.
 In December 2013, Respondent pled guilty to leaving the scene of a motor vehicle accident after damaging a car and being told to pull over and park by a law enforcement officer. When he drove away, his truck's mirror struck the officer, but did not injure him.
 Respondent received notice of the hearing, but was neither present nor represented by counsel.
