SUMMARY:

Carol M. Dunn holds an initial professional certificate of license to teach in the area of Social Science, grades 9–12. Her certification expired on May 14, 2014. Ms. Dunn is not currently teaching in Missouri.

On May 10, 2012, Ms. Dunn pled guilty to the Felony, Theft/Stealing. Ms. Dunn agreed to enter into the Restorative Justice Program Agreement and was directed to follow all Program directives.

On May 6, 2014, Ms. Dunn successfully completed the Restorative Justice Program and met all the terms of her probation including payment of restitution to the victim. As a result, the court dismissed the charges against her.

Ms. Dunn received notice of the hearing, but was neither present nor represented by counsel.
