DEPARTMENT GOAL NO. 3:

Missouri will prepare, develop, and support effective educators.

SUMMARY:

Sang Thi Duong holds a content substitute certificate of license to teach. Ms. Duong is not currently teaching in Missouri.

On December 9, 1998, Ms. Duong pled guilty and received a suspended imposition of sentence to the Misdemeanor, Stealing. Ms. Duong was placed on two (2) years' unsupervised probation.

On March 17, 2014, Ms. Duong pled guilty and received a suspended execution of sentence to the Misdemeanor, Theft/Stealing. Ms. Duong was placed on two (2) years' supervised probation. Ms. Duong is currently on probation.

Ms. Duong was present for the hearing, but was not represented by counsel.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the State Board of Education revoke Ms. Duong's teaching certificate pursuant to its authority under Mo. Rev. Stat. § 168.071 (Supp. 2014).
