EOC Exemption Reporting

Required End-of-Course Assessments

All graduating seniors are required to complete the end of course assessment in

- *Algebra I
- *English II
- *Biology
- *Government

The Department will review all students reported as current year graduates by your district to ensure that each graduate participated in each of the four assessments. If a student graduates without participating or without evidence of prior accountability, the student will be added to the district's accountable number and the district will receive a LND for that student in that content area.



EOC History Report by Student

An EOC History Report, by student, is available via the MCDS Portal.

- Logon to the secure-side of the MCDS Portal
- On the far left side choose the tab Students
- On the top of the portal page choose Reports & Resources
- Scroll down until you see EOC History Report
- Choose EOC History Report



EOC History Report by Student Continued

- User must have the following access:
 - MAP Results Student Level
- The report contains student participation (no score) information on all assessments taken.
- The student will be provided in the report, if the student was marked as enrolled on the count date in the MOSIS October or February Student Core Files.



MAP History

- Logon to the secure-side of the MCDS Portal
- On the far left side choose the tab Students
- On the top of the portal page choose Reports & Resources
- Scroll down until you see MAP History or MAP History Tabular
- Choose MAP History Tabular
 - Use this version to obtain student test scores in a tabular format. However, this file does not contain the participation information for the 2017 EOCs in A1 and E2 due to scoring issues.



Reporting EOC Exceptions

- **If a student has not participated, districts have three options.**
 - 1) You may enroll the student in the spring administration of the assessment.
 - 2) You may report to the department those students who had prior accountability fulfillment through the EOC Exception Collection.
 - 3) You may not respond and accept the Level Not Determined (LND) for the student. (Reminder: No points are awarded if the LND is greater than or equal to 5%.)



Reporting EOC Exceptions Continued

- **MOSIS Collection – “EOC Exception”**
- EOC Exception “download” report.
- A report has been added to the MOSIS **FEBRUARY** Student Core cycle.
- This report allows a district to download students reported as a 12th grader (and enrolled in the district on the last Wednesday in January) that do not have an EOC assessment record. This report will be preformatted for the EOC Exception file layout.
- The district will need to modify this report before submitting it to the Department – students may need to be removed (took the assessment during the spring administration) added to the file (not enrolled at the time the report was generated) AND the exception reason will need to be added for all students left in the report.



EOC Exceptions Codes

- **EOC Exception Codes are only used for current year graduates.**
- EOC EX2: Student received content out-of-state; in a private, parochial or home school.
- EOC EX3: MAP-Alternate – Students identified by the IEP team received content without an alternate assessment available. Currently this is only applicable to Social Studies.
- EOC EX4: Student took content in another public Missouri district, but was not assessed



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
