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This agreement is between the State Agency (SA), Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, (DESE) Food and Nutrition Services and the LEA listed above and covers the period from July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020.

The undersigned has the authority to enter this Agreement to participate in the Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program (FFVP). The Food, Conservation and Energy Act of 2008 amended the Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Act by adding Section 19, The FFVP.

A. It is mutually agreed between the SA and the LEA that:

1. The LEA agrees that the funds will only be used for the purposes authorized by Section 19 of the Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Act.
2. The LEA agrees to abide by all of the requirements for administering the Program as stated in Section 19 of the Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Act.
3. The LEA agrees to provide funds to the selected school(s), namely _____, under its jurisdiction for the service of approved fresh fruits and vegetables in accordance with local, State, and Federal regulations and requirements.
4. The LEA agrees that the schools identified in number 3 will implement the program in accordance with the plan outlined in the signed SA FFVP Application.

B. General Conditions

1. This Agreement is non-transferable.
2. Neither the SA nor the LEA has an obligation to renew this agreement.
