SUMMARY:

Applicant's Name: Tracy E. Frye

On December 10, 2014, Mr. Frye applied for a substitute certificate of license to teach.

Offense: October 8, 2008, Mr. Frye, age 47, operated a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol. He was previously convicted of the same offense on June 16, 1983 and November 15, 2007.

Disposition: On March 10, 2009, Mr. Frye pleaded guilty and received a suspended execution of sentence to the Felony, DWI-Alcohol-Persistent Offender, in the Circuit Court of McDonald County, case number 08MC-CR01584-01. Mr. Frye was sentenced to five (5) years' supervised probation, with an early release on June 13, 2013.
