SUMMARY:

5 CSR 60-120.050 authorizes school districts to request approval from the State Board of Education to change affiliation from one area vocational school to another based upon written application submitted to the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, by November 1, for the next school year.

By letter dated October 2, 2013, the Glasgow School District has made application to change the district’s affiliation from the Boonslick Technical Education Center to the Moberly Area Technical Center beginning with the 2014-15 school year. Accompanying this application is a letter from the Moberly Area Technical Center in support of the change in affiliation.

Based on the information presented by the school districts involved, the Department is recommending that change in affiliation be approved.
