SUMMARY:

Marvin E. Hamilton holds a substitute certificate of license to teach that was issued on August 11, 2011 and is set to expire on August 11, 2015. Mr. Hamilton is not currently teaching in Missouri.

On August 13, 2012, Mr. Hamilton pled guilty to and received a suspended imposition of sentence to the Felony, Possession of a Controlled Substance. Mr. Hamilton received two (2) years' supervised probation.

Mr. Hamilton received notice of the hearing, but was neither present nor represented by counsel.
