DEPARTMENT GOAL NO. 3:  
  
 Missouri will prepare, develop, and support effective educators.

SUMMARY:  
  
 Carrie Hardy, Respondent, holds a substitute certificate of license to teach that will expire on September 27, 2015.

In 2007, Respondent pled guilty to driving while intoxicated, received a suspended execution of sentence and was placed on unsupervised probation. In 2011, Respondent pled guilty to driving while intoxicated – prior offender and second degree child endangerment after driving off the road while intoxicated with her daughter in the back seat. Respondent was placed on probation with numerous conditions. Respondent immediately violated her probation, which the court revoked, but then reinstated on the same terms and conditions.

Respondent received notice of the hearing, but was not present and was not represented by counsel.
