**SUMMARY:**

Lucy L. Hauck holds a lifetime certificate of license to teach in the area of Elementary Education, grades 1–8. Ms. Hauck is not currently teaching in Missouri.

On December 5, 2013, Ms. Hauck pled guilty and received a suspended execution of sentence to the Felony, Driving While Intoxicated (DWI) – Alcohol – Persistent Offender. Ms. Hauck was placed on five (5) years' supervised probation with conditions including the use of an alcohol monitoring device, shock time, and alcohol/drug evaluation and treatment.

Ms. Hauck received notice of the hearing, but was neither present nor represented through counsel.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the State Board of Education revoke Ms. Hauck's teaching certificate pursuant to its authority under Mo. Rev. Stat. § 168.071 (Supp. 2014).
