DEPARTMENT GOAL NO. 3:

Missouri will prepare, develop, and support effective educators.

SUMMARY:

Mo. Rev. Stat. §168.071 authorizes the State Board of Education to discipline certificates of license to teach, which includes the authority to resolve issues by consent agreement or agreed settlement or voluntary surrender of the certificate of license. 5 CSR 20-400.230 provides that the State Board of Education may accept a voluntary surrender or informally settle a case through a consent agreement or agreed settlement.

Terry R. Hendrickson holds a career continuous professional certificate of license to teach in the area of English, grades 9–12.

On March 7, 2016, a judgment was entered against Mr. Hendrickson in the Circuit Court of Taney County, Missouri finding him guilty of the Misdemeanor, Assault 3rd Degree. As part of the disposition of the criminal charges, Mr. Hendrickson agreed to surrender his certificate of license to teach. Mr. Hendrickson signed a statement of surrender waiving all procedural rights regarding revocation of his certificate of license to teach.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department recommends that the State Board of Education accept Mr. Hendrickson’s statement of surrender and revoke his teaching certificate in disposition of his criminal conviction.
