SUMMARY:

Devion J. Hunter holds a substitute certificate of license to teach, issued on August 22, 2012, which expires on August 22, 2016.

On May 12, 2014, Mr. Hunter pled guilty and received a suspended execution of sentence to the Felony, Burglary–2nd degree; Felony, Resisting Arrest; and Felony, Possession of Burglary Tools. He was placed on five (5) years' supervised probation. Mr. Hunter also pled guilty to the Misdemeanor, Stealing and was sentenced to 60 days, time served in the St. Louis Medium Security Institution.

Mr. Hunter received notice of the hearing, but was neither present nor represented through counsel.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the State Board of Education revoke Mr. Hunter's teaching certificate pursuant to its authority under Mo. Rev. Stat. § 168.071 (Supp. 2014).
