STRATEGIC PRIORITIES			
Access, Opportunity, Equity – Provide all students access to a broad range of high quality educational opportunities from early learning into post-high school engagement.			
Teachers and Leaders – Prepare, develop and support educators to ensure an effective teacher in every classroom and an effective leader in every school.			
SUMMARY			
The Normandy School District was classified as unaccredited on January 1, 2013. On May 20, 2014, the State Board of Education (State Board) lapsed the Normandy School District and authorized the establishment of the Joint Executive Governing Board (JEGB) to provide leadership for the Normandy Schools Collaborative until June 30, 2017.			
In May 2017, the State Board of Education authorized the continuation/extension of the Joint Executive Governing Board until June 30, 2020. On June 25, 2019, the Department was notified by Rev. Portis that he would like to resign his position on the JEGB, effective at the close of the JEGB meeting on July 22, 2019.			
A candidate, who will replace Rev. Cedric Portis and serve a term effective immediately, will be presented for consideration by the State Board. The candidate would serve until June 30, 2020, unless extended by the State Board prior to that date or until the JEGB is dissolved by action of the State Board of Education.

RECOMMENDATION			
The Department recommends that the State Board of Education appoint Karen Pierre to serve on the Joint Executive Governing Board for Normandy Schools Collaborative through June 30, 2020, as presented.
