SUMMARY:

Applicant's Name: Demetria L. Jackson

On December 15, 2014, Ms. Jackson applied for a substitute certificate of license to teach. On February 13, 2015, Ms. Jackson applied for a temporary authorization certificate of license to teach in the area of Practical Nurse, Post-Secondary.

Offense: On December 10, 2002, Ms. Jackson, age 21, committed retail theft over \$150. As an employee of Target, she knowingly under rang 11 out of 16 items of merchandise on one (1) sale, with the stolen merchandise amount totaling \$472.69.

Disposition: On March 4, 2003, Ms. Jackson pleaded guilty to the Felony, Retail Theft, in the Circuit Court of St. Clair County, state of Illinois, case number 02CF1402. She was sentenced to one (1) year supervised probation.

Letters of Recommendation: Four (4) – (Registered Nurse, Assistant Principal, Coordinator, Administrator).
