6 Cent Certification Approval

Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE), School Food Services (SFS) are continuing to accept 6 cent certification documents. Currently 300 Local Education Agencies (LEAs) have submitted documents to be certified for performance based reimbursement. Our office has approved 216 of those submitted. SFS staff is working diligently with LEAs to approve the certification documents and are currently working with those submitted in late November and early December. If you feel you have submitted documents prior to December and have not been contacted by SFS staff, please contact our office to find out the status of your certification.
