**SUMMARY:**

Applicant's Name: Terrance E. Lee, II

On June 16, 2014, Mr. Lee applied for a substitute certificate of license to teach.

Offense: On September 22, 2002, Mr. Lee, age 22, and acting with another, appropriated two (2) ten (10) inch XPLODE XS-L1046 subwoofers in possession of Audio Express without consent.

Disposition: On January 6, 2003, Mr. Lee pled guilty and received a suspended execution of sentence to the Felony, Stealing-Felony-Other, in the Circuit Court of St. Louis County, case number 2102R-05171A-01. Mr. Lee was sentenced to five (5) years' supervised probation, which was completed on January 5, 2008.
