DEPARTMENT GOAL NO. 3:

Missouri will prepare, develop, and support effective educators.

SUMMARY:

Dalon G. Lee, held a content substitute certificate of license to teach. It was issued on November 17, 2011, and expired on November 17, 2015. Mr. Lee is not currently teaching in a Missouri public school.

Mr. Lee physically manhandled two students leaving marks on one student by pushing him up against a wall and placing the other student in a headlock as well as threatening him. Mr. Lee’s actions were witnessed in full or in part by several staff, including the security officer. Out of concern for the students’ safety, the security officer escorted Mr. Lee from the building.

Mr. Lee was neither present at the hearing, nor was he represented through counsel.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department recommends that the State Board of Education revoke Mr. Lee’s certificate or any claim of certification pursuant to its authority under Mo. Rev. Stat. § 168.071 (Supp. 2014).
