SUMMARY:

Chris A. Lillard, Respondent, holds a lifetime certificate of license to teach in physical education, grades K-12. His certification is current and active.

From 1997 through 2010 Respondent pled guilty to four (4) driving while intoxicated offenses, two (2) of which were felonies, and one (1) misdemeanor stealing offense. During this time period, he violated his probation three (3) times by driving under the influence.

Respondent received notice of the hearing, but was neither present nor represented by counsel.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the State Board of Education revoke Respondent's teaching certificate pursuant to its authority under Mo. Rev. Stat. § 168.071 (Supp. 2013).
